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- Recognize the role of EMS and ED in acute stroke management.
- Identify the evolving role of endovascular care given the recent new data.
- Summarize the medical and nursing management of the hemorrhagic stroke patient.
- Identify potential areas of cognitive change in children and adolescents post stroke and how brain development factors can impact recovery and cognitive functioning.
- Recognize the etiology of cardioembolic stroke and treatment strategies to reduce stroke reoccurrence.
- Identify the increased risk of stroke in patients with drug abuse and appropriate clinical assessment and treatment.
- Identify the etiology and clinical presentation of cerebral sinus venous thrombosis and arteriovenous malformation and the appropriate interventional treatment.
- Identify obstructive sleep apnea as a preventable, treatable and reversible cause of stroke.
- Discuss how tiered level of care and clinical team decision making within a stroke systems of care can positively impact patient outcomes.
- Explain the perspective from a patient and family treated through the continuum of care for an acute stroke with unknown etiology.
