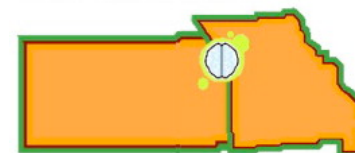

# Program Overview

This class is designed to provide a unique perspective of stroke care. Content will focus on the contributions of the multidisciplinary team. Topics include: ICH treatment, Vestibular Rehab Therapy, Neuro-visual deficits, comprehensive driving assessment, and Support Group Panel.

## Objectives

Upon completion of this program, the participant will be able to:

1. Review the latest recommendations for ICH treatment, timing of craniectomy, and edema management.
2. Discuss the results/recommendations from the MISTIE ICH Trial and CLEAR IVH Trial.
3. Describe how Vestibular Rehab Therapy can alleviate symptoms of vertigo/dizziness in the post-stroke patient.
4. Illustrate the process involved in the comprehensive clinical assessment of the stroke patient resuming driving.
5. Recognize the benefits of Stroke Support Groups and their impact on the lives of the stroke survivor and their caregiver.
6. List the causes for acute dizziness and imbalance.
